Description of the Award

Awarded to current undergraduate or graduate Athabasca University (AU) program students who have achieved a cumulative AU grade point average (GPA) of 3.60 or higher and have completed at least 15 AU credits. Recipients will be selected based on involvement in, and contributions to, AU's community and/or governance. Students are only eligible to receive this award once within any five-year period.

Conditions of Eligibility

An applicant must meet the following criteria to be eligible to apply for this award:

- Enrolment in an AU undergraduate or graduate program
- Is a current (active) student
- Cumulative AU GPA of 3.60 or higher
- Completion of 15 AU credits or more
- Has not received this award previously
