Athabasca University approves and awards credentials every month. All requirements for the credential must be completed by the 15th of the month in order to graduate the following month.

Upon receipt of the Application for Graduation Form, the Office of the Registrar will monitor your progress in Athabasca University courses until all final grades are received and advise you by letter that you are eligible to graduate. It is the student's responsibility to submit transcripts for course work completed at other institutions. Once the credential is awarded, the parchment is mailed to the address on the Application for Graduation Form.

\* Your name, as it is recorded on your student academic record, will be displayed on the parchment. If you have recently changed your name, or would like to make changes to what we have recorded on your student file, you must officially notify the Office of the Registrar by completing and submitting the Student Change of Information Form available online at:
